

## GOHWP Meeting Notes, May 30 2018

Mary updated Recia on an informal meeting held prior to the GOHWP meeting at the SIOP conference. An enhanced focus on HWP-relevant jobs/internships is one possible direction, and providing more materials for the development of HWP-related courses is another.

Morrie reported that he's asked his graduate student (Wes Wattenberger) to start gathering lists of resources related to HWP job opportunities, and has discussed revamping the GOHWP website with Drew to think about how to best present the new focus.

**ACTION ITEM:** Other Board members are asked to also work on finding job-related resources that we can use to build ourselves as a resource, so that Wes is not the only one building the list. Morrie is happy to provide Wes's contact information to anyone interested in coordinating on this effort.

Recia raised the issue of whether we want to provide a certificate of membership to new members. Mary felt that this was not something to do right now. Inusah pointed out that this is something we may need to look at going forward, because of the positive regard associated with receiving a formal recognition of member status. Morrie noted that an initial way of doing this would be designing a PDF or similar document that could be quickly customized with the name of a new member and verify their membership status.

Mary noted that an update from the Ghana Local Chapter of GOHWP would be wonderful to feature, to encourage the creation of more local chapters. Inusah indicated that he can provide an update for the website.
